2 Continue shopping until you have at least three PSO events in your basket, then click "Proceed to Checkout." Remember that you will need to purchase at least three PSO events in one transaction for the discount to be applied.

3 At the payment screen, enter your login information if you are not already logged in. Confirm delivery details and address, then choose your delivery method.

4 Check the box next to "Use Discount Coupons." Enter code "CYO11" and click "Add Coupon." You will see your 10% discount automatically applied to the ticket prices and per-ticket service charge reduced to \$2. To complete your order, enter payment information and click "Submit."
