Please check out our POPS! series and Discovery concerts which are sure to excite, educate, and entertain. Finally, I am happy to report that the next "Magic of Christmas" is already in the works!

My first season with the PSO has been an inspiring experience and the entire PSO family has been extremely welcoming. I look forward to playing all this wonderful music with the best collaborators one can wish for — the fantastic musicians of the Portland Symphony.


